HANDS-ON WORKSHOPS:

One hour of structured activities based on a theme of your choice to fit your children, **ages 3 and up**. A two-hour visit includes time to explore the hands-on exhibits. Add a half hour for snack or lunch.

Animals

Meet some of the animals that live at the museum, act out a story with animal characters, play an animal game and make a craft.

Around the World

Visit different cultures from around the world through music, storytelling, games and crafts. Can be tailored to specific cultures of your choice.

Chesapeake Critters

Games, crafts, songs. Look for native woodlands and wetlands wildlife (weather permitting).



Recommended for ages 5 and up:

Creating with the Masters

Inspired by the lives and works of such masters as: Alexander Calder, Marc Chagall, Jacob Lawrence, Claude Monet, Georgia O'Keeffe, Pablo Picasso, or Andy Warhol

Deconstruction

Take apart a machine to see how it's put together. Go on a scavenger hunt to find moving parts all around the museum. Design a new invention with moving parts.

Taking Off!

Learn about events and people in aviation history. Experiment with flying objects of your own making.

Lead On, Harriet!

Meet the famous conductor from the Underground Railroad. Can be arranged as an off-site workshop at your location. Ages 9 to adult. *Optional: 2 hour program with snack for \$10 per person.*

The Skin You Live In

Find out about melanin, human migration, genetics and why people come packaged in different colors. Hands-on activities include matching our skin tones with ingredients from the kitchen. *Optional: add \$1 per child to bake potato skins!*

Sharecropping the Sea

Hear about living off the Chesapeake from the point of view of a waterman from long ago. Dress for outdoor activity.

A) Theme Workshop

recommended for ages 5 & up
\$9 per child up to 15 children
\$8 ea for 16 or more children

B) Free Play (no workshop)

\$4 per child

Time: two hours. Let us know if you'd like to bring lunch or snack to have before or after your visit.


